We teach trainees how to design, build and manage technology platforms that host and deliver online and remote learning programs and curriculums offered by social-cause organizations.



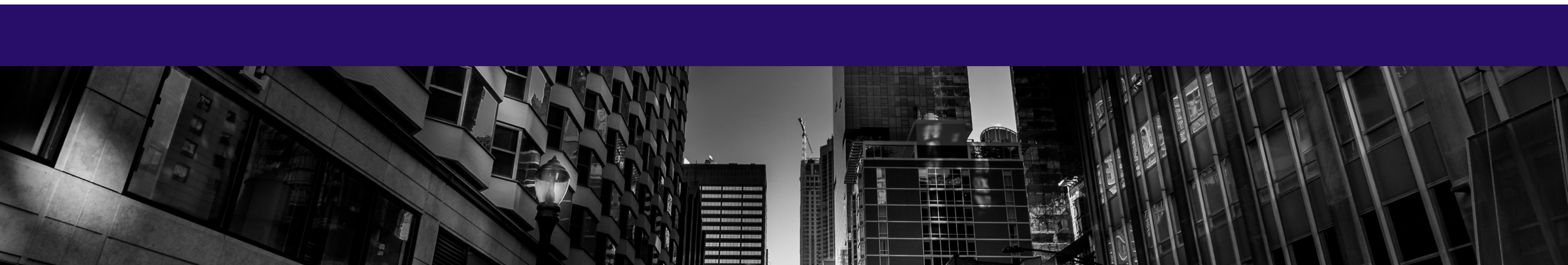
Outreach

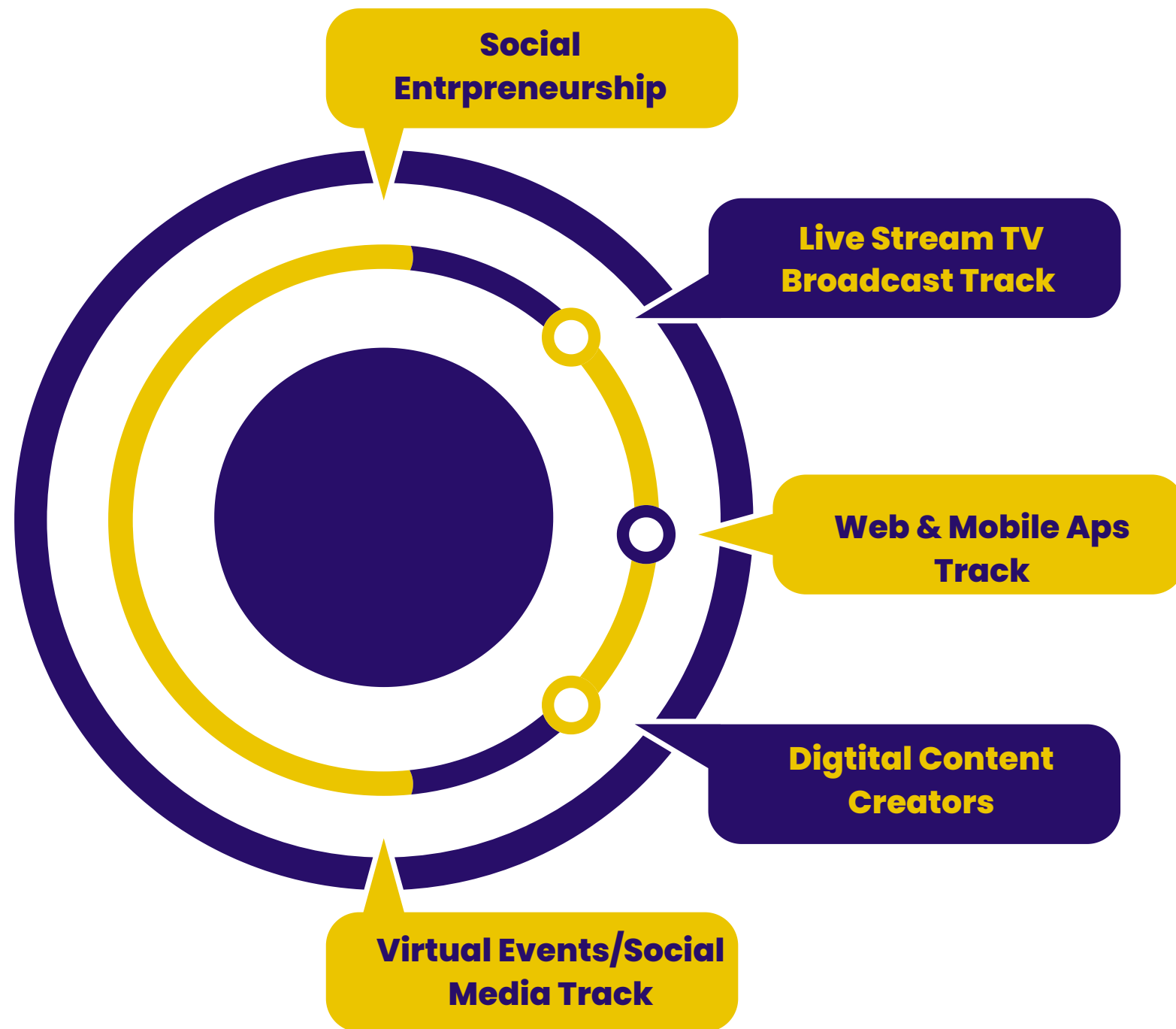

FLEXIBLE LEARNING TRACKS AND TRAINING SCHEDULES



Monday-Thursday

Our Bootcamp is designed with multiple training tracks. All tracks consist of lectures and labs. All training is hands-on, project-based learning.

Lectures will run from 10:0a.m. - 12:00 noon, and 3:00 p.m. Labs and expos are from 1:00 pm. - 4:00 p.m. Evening Training from - 5:00p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Friday and Saturday

We realize that some trainees work during the day so our lectures and labs will also take place during weekend hours beginning Friday at 3:00 p.m.

Friday Lectures will run 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Friday Labs will run from 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.
Weekend trainees are also required to attend Saturday from 10:00a.m. - 4:00 p.m. with a 1/2 lunch break.

IDEAL CANDIDATES TO ATTEND OUR FAITH & TECHNOLOGY BOOTCAMP

All candidates will be interviewed to determine if they are a good fit to attend our Bootcamp. Ideal candidates are:

- Volunteers currently in Tech Ministry at a Church.
- Interested in pursuing a career in Technology.
- Has a curiosity to learn a new technology skill.
- Must be willing to learn how to apply and use technology in a ministry and mission context.
- Persons reentering society from incarceration.
- Unemployed, Underemployed and lack employable work skills.
- Preferred to have a High School Diploma or GED.
- Must be at least 19 years of age.
- Able to go through a background check and drug screening with DX Tech or sponsoring organization.



Our Virtual Campus instructors are men and women who are practicing professionals in the digital transformation field. We are also Faith leaders and Social Entrepreneurs who have a sincere interest to transform lives and communities, helping to improve the socio/economic status of disadvantaged people.
