
WHO ARE WE

Live Stream Broadcast



All candidates will be interviewed to determine if they are a good fit to attend our Bootcamp. Ideal candidates are:


- Volunteers currently in Tech Ministry for Church.

FLEXIBLE LEARNING TRACKS AND TRAINING SCHEDULES

Our Bootcamp is designed with multiple training tracks. All tracks consist of lectures and labs. Most of the training is hands-on, project-based learning.

Lectures will run from 10:0a.m. - 12:00 noon, and 3:00 p.m. Labs and expos are from 1:00 pm. - 4:00 p.m. Evening Training from - 5:00p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Friday and Saturday

We realize that some trainees work during the day so our lectures and labs will also take place during weekend hours beginning Friday at 3:00 p.m.

Friday Lectures will run 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. Friday Labs will run from 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. Weekend trainees are also required to attend Saturday from 10:00a.m. - 4:00 p.m. with a 1/2 lunch break.


